After months of consideration, session has decided to **ADD** the acceptance of credit cards. (Nothing else is changed. Cash and checks, by mail, in offering plates, or in person are still welcomed!)

A few might prefer using a credit card and the web site allows our supporters to easily contribute financially to our ministry and mission even if they do not attend services or live elsewhere. *This is an option, no one has to use a credit card or the web site to contribute!*

Your financial people and session are monitoring the use of credit cards. It is possible session will expand the funds available for credit card payments or withdraw from the program. There are no plans to accept credit card payments other than via the web site.

There is no monthly minimum fee for accepting credit cards via the web site. Instead, we pay a percentage of each payment for the ability to accept credit card payments.
